Did You Know?

- Idaho missed out on over \$470 million from 2010 to 2019 due to incomplete census data.
- Valley County receives approximately \$1,483 per resident per year based on county population.
- Where you register with the census is kept confidential and never linked to other governmental requirements like property tax exemptions or mailing addresses.
- If you spend 50% of your time in Valley County, you can consider it home, per the census.
- Mandated by the Constitution: The U.S. has counted its population every 10 years since 1790.

The census can shape many different aspects of your community. Each year, the results help determine how more than \$675 billion in federal funding is distributed to states and communities.
